**WORD**

*For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men.*

Titus 2:11

God's saving grace starts our relationship with Him and a life that can easily tap into His grace.

Yet oftentimes, we do not understand this grace because we are used to earning the things that we need. These three points will help us understand God's saving grace and what it does in our lives.

**1. Saving grace is about God's gift, not something we can earn.**

*<sup>8</sup>For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God — <sup>9</sup>not by works, so that no one can boast.*

Ephesians 2:8,9

Salvation is a gift from God and therefore all we need to do is receive this gift by accepting Jesus as our Lord and Savior. This gift is dependent on the Giver and not earned by us. Why can't we earn salvation (Romans 3:22-24)?

**2. Saving grace is God forgiving us all our sins and giving us eternal life through Jesus.**

*<sup>4</sup>But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, <sup>5</sup>made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions — it is by grace you have been saved.*

Ephesians 2:5

*For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Romans 6:23

Sin is to be repaid with death and we know that every person has sinned. But by God's grace and mercy, Jesus paid our debts so we can be forgiven and so we can have eternal life. What did Jesus do to make this possible?
